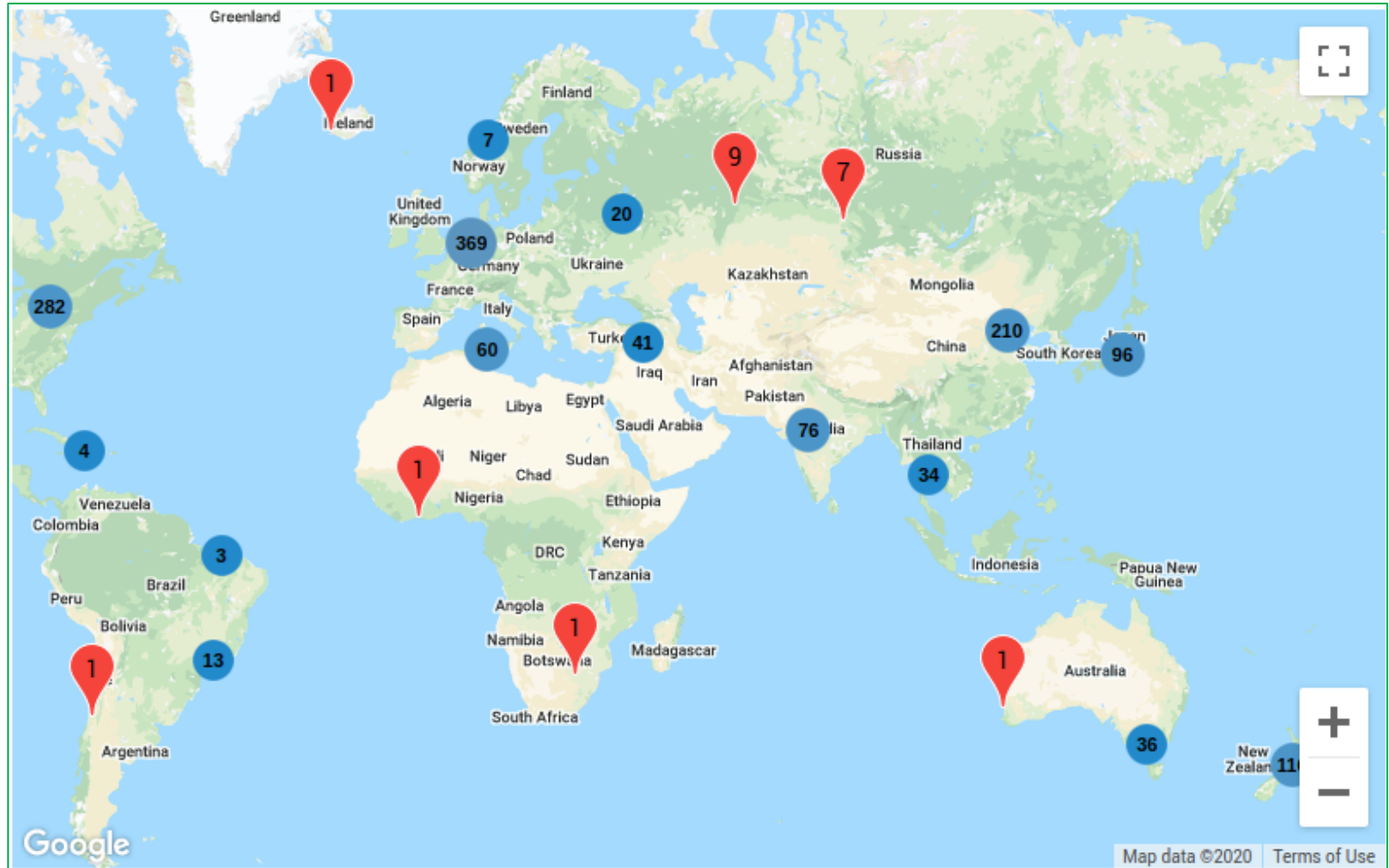

# What's Publons? - <https://publons.com>

- Researcher profile from Clarivate, powered by Web of Science and by partnerships with scholarly journals
- Public profile
- 'Claim' **publications** in Web of Science, via ResearcherID
- Journal & conference **reviews** can be added
  - Automatically
  - Manually
- Private dashboard
  - Publication Metrics (can be added to the public profile)
  - Citation Map – geographical representation of your citations across the globe
  - Author Impact Beamplot – visualization of citation performance based on normalized citation percentiles

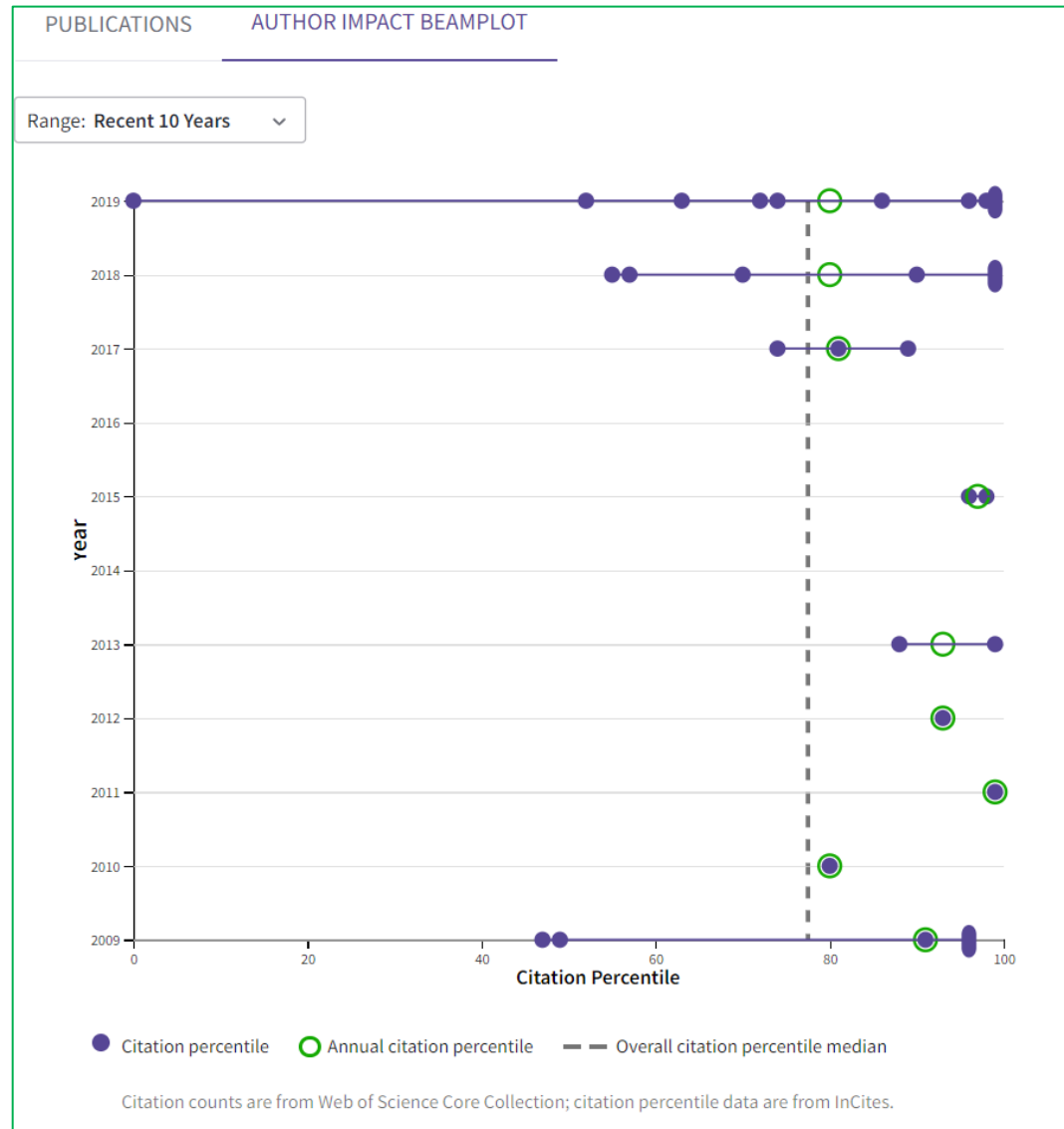

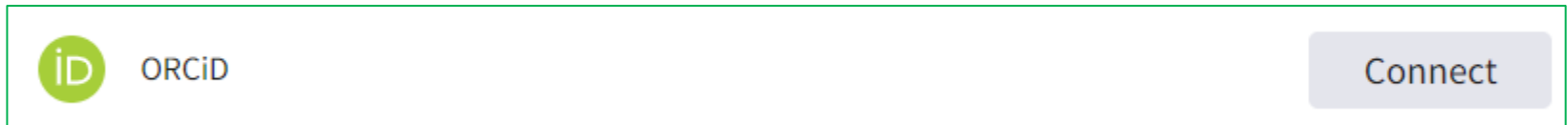

- Publications in your ORCID record with
  - A DOI
  - Visibility setting = everyoneWill have your ORCID iD displayed in Web of Science  
Source: Public API of ORCID
- By using Publons it's possible to add
  - Meeting abstracts
  - Book reviews
- In Publons: My records > Publications > Import from Web of Science
  - Search by name and email address
- In WoS: Export > Claim on Publons – track citations



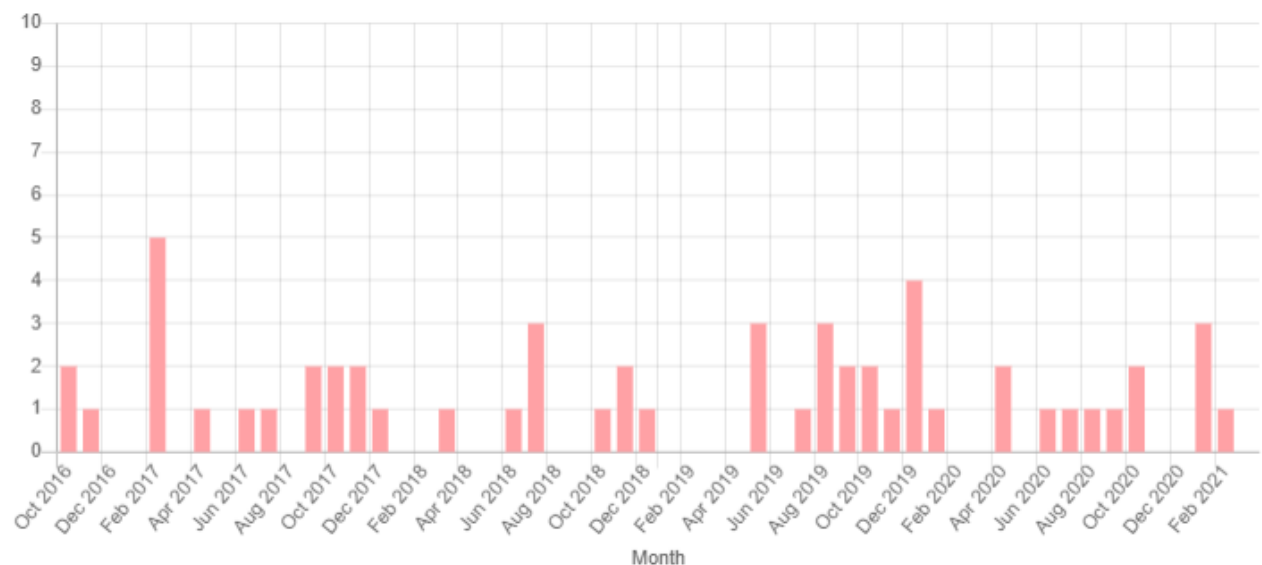

# Example: APA

## Get Recognized for Peer Review



Integrated with APA's peer review submission system, Publons is a service that provides instant recognition for peer review and enables APA reviewers and action editors to maintain a verified record of their contributions for promotion and funding applications.

You can opt-in to have your reviews for participating APA journals automatically added to your Publons profile.

## What is Publons?

Publons helps you to record, verify, and showcase your peer review contributions for use in promotion and funding applications. You get recognition even if your reviews are anonymous and the manuscript is never published.

Publons gives recognition for peer review without compromising reviewer anonymity or infringing upon journal policies. By default, the content of the review will not be publicly displayed, and only the year of the review and the journal title will be shown on reviewer profiles.

You may edit what is displayed for any review or opt out of the service at any time.

## How Does Publons Work?

When reviewing for an integrated journal:

- You will be asked if you want to get recognition for it on Publons
- Once your review is completed you will receive an email with a private link to claim your review
- Follow the link to add your review to your reviewer profile

# Adding peer review activities

1. Partnered journals - question in the review submission form
  - Adding via confirmation e-mail
  - Adding automatically (permission)
  - Please note: verified e-mail addresses are used to match
2. Send review receipts to reviews@publons.com
  - 'thank you for reviewing e-mail' from the journal editor
3. Via auto-updates
  - Going back 5 years, match by verified e-mails
4. Via forms on Publons

TRANSPARENT PEER REVIEW 

*International Journal of Social Economics operates Transparent Peer Review which means that pre-publication reviewer reports, decision letters, and author responses for certain articles can be displayed publicly even if their standard review policy would preclude it.*

- Authors can opt-out of publicly displaying the article's peer review content
- Reviewers can choose to sign their reviewer reports with their name or as anonymous
